# **RING ONE**

**10.00am start**

## **CLASS 1 BEGINNERS WORKING PONY**

*Pony of any type or breed – Rider 16 years and under, snaffle bits only. Lead reins should be attached to the noseband, will be required to jump a course of fences and perform an individual show, walk and trot only*

*Height of fences (30 cm approx)*

*Class will be split LEAD REIN and OFF LEAD REIN*

## **CLASS 2 WORKING PONY**

*Pony of any type or breed, pony **not to exceed 153 cm** will be required to jump a course of fences and perform an individual show. Height of fences (55-60 cm approx)*

## **CLASS 3 WORKING HORSE**

*Horse of any type or breed **exceeding 153 cm** will be required to jump a course of fences and perform an individual show. Height of fences (60-70 cm approx)*

## **CLASS 4 NOVICE RIDDEN HORSE**

*Horse of any type or breed **exceeding 153 cm**. Horse not to have been placed 1st in any ridden showing class, walk and trot only, in individual show canter will be expected. Snaffle bridles only.*

***LUNCH BREAK – CLASS 5 will not start before 1pm.***

## **CLASS 5 RIDING HORSE/ HACK**

*Horses of Riding Horse and Hack Type.*

## **CLASS 6 RIDDEN FOREIGN BREEDS**

*Horse or pony of any foreign breed (nonindigenous to the British isles) can be shown in English dress or dress appropriate to their breed.*

## **CLASS 7 RIDDEN COB**

*Open to show and traditional cobs*

## **CLASS 8 RIDDEN HUNTER**

*Horses of Hunter type*

## **CLASS 9 CONCOURS D'ELEGANCE** *(Period dress)*

*Lead Rein permitted. This class **will not be eligible** for the Ring Championship*

## **RING CHAMPIONSHIP**

*1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners from all classes in RING ONE are eligible to compete.*

***Champion and Reserve Champion will then be able to compete for Supreme of Show. Held in Ring one at the end of the Show***

## **SUPREME CHAMPIONSHIP OF SHOW-*To be held in Ring one***

Champion and Reserve Champions from RING ONE, RING TWO and RING THREE to compete for Supreme of Show. This will be judged by all three ring judges. Supreme Champion will receive a Supreme Champion of Show Sash.

## **RING TWO**

**10.00am start**

### **CLASS 10 NOVICE RIDDEN PONY**

*Horse or Pony of any type or breed **not to exceed 153 cm** and not to have been placed 1st in any ridden showing class, walk and trot only, in individual show canter will be expected. Snaffle bridles only.*

### **CLASS 11 RIDDEN COLOURED**

*Horse or Pony of any breed or type. Can be shown in traditional, plated or natural state*

### **CLASS 12 RIDDEN SMALL BREED MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**

*Welsh A, B, Shetlands, Dartmoor and Exmoor ponies to be shown in natural state*

### **CLASS 13 RIDDEN VETERANS**

*Horse or Pony any type or breed – 15 years and over*

**LUNCH BREAK – CLASS 14 will not start before 1pm.**

### **CLASS 14 RIDDEN LARGE BREED MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**

*Open to Welsh C, D, Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Dales and Fell ponies to be shown in natural state*

### **CLASS 15 LEAD REIN PONY**

*Any type or breed – Rider 9 years and under, snaffle bits only and lead rein should be attached to the noseband, walk and trot only*

### **CLASS 16 FIRST RIDDEN PONY**

*Any type or breed under 133cm rider 12 years and under walk and trot only as a group, canter is optional in individual show*

## **RING CHAMPIONSHIP**

*1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners from all classes in RING TWO are eligible to compete.*

*Champion and Reserve Champion will then be able to compete for Supreme of Show in Ring 1 at the end of the show.*

## **RING THREE**

**9.30am start**

### **CLASS 17 INHAND YOUNG STOCK**

*Horse or Pony of any type or Breed aged 1, 2 and 3 years old*

### **CLASS 18 INHAND FOREIGN BREEDS**

*Horse or pony any foreign breed (nonindigenous to the British isles) can be shown in English dress or dress appropriate to their breed.*

### **CLASS 19 INHAND RIDING HORSE/ HACK/ HUNTER**

*Horses of Hunter, Hack or Riding Horse type*

### **CLASS 20 YOUNG HANDLER**

*Horse or Pony any type or breed – Handler to be 12 years or under*

### **CLASS 21 INHAND COLOURED**

*Horse or Pony of any breed or type. Can be shown in traditional, plated or natural state*

**LUNCH BREAK – CLASS 22 will not start before 1pm.**

### **CLASS 22 INHAND SMALL BREED MOUNTAIN AND MOORLAND**

*Welsh A, B, Shetlands, Dartmoor and Exmoor to be shown in natural state.*

### **CLASS 23 INHAND COB**

*Open to show or traditional cobs*

### **CLASS 24 INHAND VETERANS**

*Horse or Pony any type or breed – 15 years and over*

### **CLASS 25 INHAND LARGE BREED MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND**

*Open to Welsh C, D, Connemara, New Forest, Highland, Dales and Fell ponies to be shown in natural state*

## **RING CHAMPIONSHIP**

*1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> placed winners from all classes in RING THREE are eligible to compete.*

*Champion and Reserve Champion will then be able to compete for Supreme of Show.*

## **BY SIGNING THE ENTRY FORM YOU AGREE TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES.**

### **D.H.H.S CLUB RULES**

1. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL.**
2. **LEGAL LIABILITY** - Neither the Organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf accept any liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury nor illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other persons or property whatsoever.
3. **HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE** - The Organiser of this Event has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the written or verbal instructions of the Organiser and all the Officials and Stewards, who will also not be liable for any claim in respect of damage, loss, injury or accident to any person, horse or property howsoever caused. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant has read and understood these terms and conditions and shall indemnify DHHS or any person acting on their behalf against any legal action arising from such an incident
4. **A responsible adult must supervise CHILDREN UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS** - at all times.
5. **JUDGING** - All classes will be judged under and in accordance with the relevant ruling body.
6. **WORKING CLASSES** – Classes will be judged according to DHHS show jumping rules with regard to penalties.

7. **DRESS** - Competitors must at all times wear correct riding clothes complete with jacket (BSJA rule 101.1) whenever they enter the arena. Long hair should be tidy and secured appropriately above the collar. Jewellery worn anywhere on the body can increase the risk of injury and competitors are strongly recommended to remove all jewellery.
8. **SPURS - Under 16s – NO SPURS** but may take part as H/C (Hors Concours *translation without competing*) therefore allowed to participate but not eligible for placing's. **Seniors** - Spurs are only to be worn in the traditionally correct manner, with the curve of the neck of the spur directed downwards. The misuse of spurs is an offence under BSJA rule 82.4, but riders must also take care that the manner in which they use their spurs does not offend the public contrary to BSJA rule 82.1. Spurs of excessively severe design are not to be worn. Such designs include spurs with necks in excess of 3cms long, necks set on the inside of the heel, rowel diameters in excess of 1cm, roughened or cutting edges, serrated spurs, with or without necks. ( BSJA 101.9)
9. **HATS** – Bowlers or hunting caps are worn at competitor's own risk. Junior riders must wear protective headgear, which includes a retaining harness secured to the shell at more than two points. Such headgear must be worn with the chinstrap properly adjusted and fastened while mounted (BSJA rule 267). It is mandatory for all hats to comply with the permitted hat standards as updated 3<sup>rd</sup> Jan 2017 PAS 015 98, PAS 2011 + KM, VGI + KM, SNELL E2001, ASTM F1163 2004 + SEI AS/NZ 38.38 2003 onwards + SAI.
10. **ENTRIES** – Are payable on the day at the time of booking.
11. **REFUNDS** - Will not be given once classes are entered.
12. **RIDDEN HORSES/PONIES** - Must be 4 years old or over.
13. **STALLION/COLTS** - Must be kept under control at all times & not handled by anyone under 14 years. All stallions must have blue ribbon in tail.
14. **DROPPINGS** - To be picked up.
15. **DOGS** - Must be kept on leads and all dog mess cleaned up.
16. **RUBBISH/LITTER** - To be removed from showground or placed in bins provided.
